RODENT CONTROL CONTINUOUS

- Place clean bait stations in appropriate numbers and locations according to product label.
- Continuous: Replenish and check bait stations weekly or as necessary.
- Complete your Rodent Control Handbook Logs (available on our Biosecurity website).

SECOND INSECT CONTROL WALL SPRAY

- Choose an approved wall spray insecticide.
- Apply insecticide solution on ALL appropriate surfaces according to insect challenge according to product label.
- Let dry and restart ventilation after appropriate contact time has elapse.

SECOND OPTIONAL DISINFECTION FOGGING / MISTING SPRAY

- Ensure that there are no puddles on floor, walls and equipment before moving on.
- Choose an appropriate product according to ambient temperature, presence of specific pathogens and contamination level.
- Prepare solution to ensure proper dilution rate and quantity to be used depending on delivery tool / method.
- Close all openings and stop ventilation.
- Fog or mist the disinfectant solution in the room / building.
- Make sure no people and no animals are present period treatment and waiting period (2 hours after).
- Re-start ventilation after appropriate contact time has elapsed.
- Let dry (all surfaces) before moving on to the NEXT STEP.

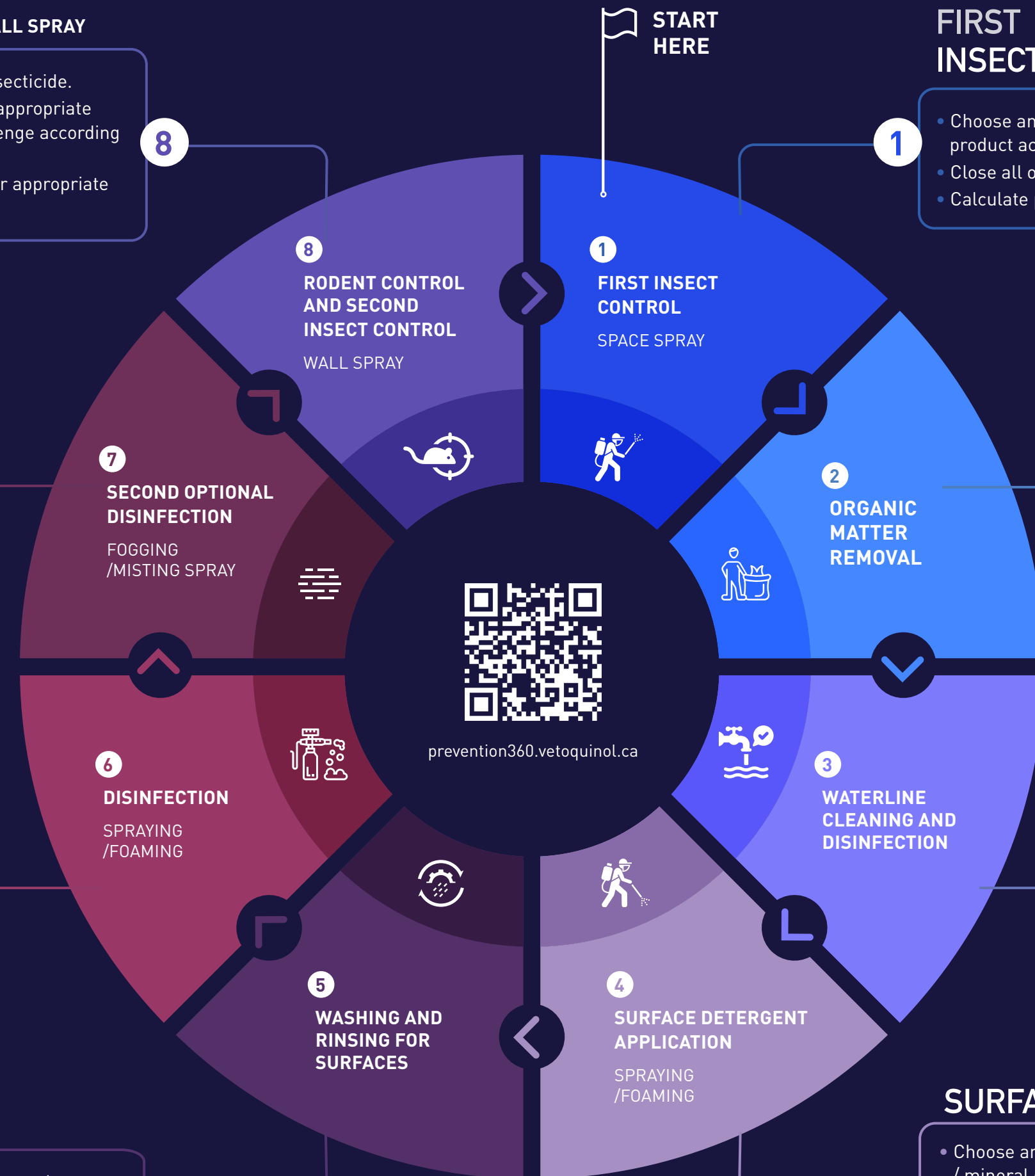
DISINFECTION SPRAYING / FOAMING

- Ensure that there are no puddles on floor, walls and equipment before moving on.
- Choose an appropriate product according to ambient temperature, presence of specific pathogens and contamination level.
- Prepare the proper stock solution and use product according to label.
- Spray or foam disinfectant solution on ALL surfaces that have been previously washed with detergent.
- Let stand wet at least 10 minutes.
- Dry as quickly as possible afterwards.

WASHING AND RINSING FOR SURFACES

- Before detergent solution dries:
 - Thoroughly rinse all surfaces with water to remove detergent and any remaining organic / mineral material.
- Let dry (no puddles on floor, walls, equipment) before moving on to the NEXT STEP.



FIRST INSECT CONTROL SPACE SPRAY

- Choose an approved rapid action space spray insecticide and use product according to label.
- Close all openings and stop ventilation.
- Calculate proper amount of product to use.
- In absence of persons and animals, fog or mist the product in the room / building.
- After a waiting period of 2 hours, re-start ventilation.

ORGANIC MATTER REMOVAL

- Empty all feed troughs.
- Remove manure, mobile equipment (including bait stations), dust, etc.
- Dispose of used manure and bedding (if present).
- If water is used in this step ensure that room / building is reasonably dry (no puddles on floor, walls, equipment) before moving on to the NEXT STEP.
- Clean and disinfect detachable feed, milk containers, water buckets and mobile equipment separately before reintroduction to the cleaned building.

Choose an appropriate detergent depending on issues: organic matter / mineral deposits. Prepare stock solution. When preparing a solution, always ensure proper dilution rate and quantity to be used depending on delivery tool / method. Inject solution into waterline. Ensure product is present everywhere in the waterline. Let stand (soaking time depends on condition of the waterline). Flush waterline. | <p>DISINFECTION</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> If required, repeat steps from the "cleaning" section using an appropriate disinfectant. |

SURFACE DETERGENT APPLICATION SPRAYING / FOAMING

- Choose an appropriate product depending on issues: organic matter / mineral deposits; or pH rotation and use product according to label.
- Prepare proper stock solution.
- Spray or foam detergent solution on ALL surfaces to be washed.
- Let stand (soaking time depends on amount of soiling on surfaces).
